#### **ACADEMIC SESSION 2023-24**

The academic session for the year 2023-24 began on 5 April for classes I to X and on 6 April for KG students. Further lift to the commencement was given by the blessing day which was intended to seek God's blessings for the school's prosperity and wellbeing of the students and staff.
